

## **Flying Saucer Seen in Perth**

**BUSINESS MAN  
CONVINCED**

**PULSATING BEAMS OF  
LIGHT**

Perth, June 29.—A Perth business man is convinced that he saw a flying saucer from his home in Alderbury street, Floreat Park, just before 8 p.m. on Sunday.

This follows a report by three motorists that they saw a mysterious light which "manoeuvred around the sky" soon after 8 p.m. on Sunday north-east of Eucla.

"If it was not a flying saucer," this Perth resident said to-day, it was a skylight phenomena that I have never seen before.

"I was sceptical about all the flying saucer reports I had read until I had this experience.

"I went out to empty some rubbish before settling down to a radio play when I saw a particularly bright object in the sky.

"It was bigger than a planet," this business man continued, "and it was clear white with pulsating beams of light radiating from its circumfer-

radiating from its circumfer-  
ence.

"Suddenly it appeared to move away. It grew smaller and disappeared from my view in about 10 seconds."

This informant added that the strange object had no lateral or horizontal movement from his position. It was about 30 degrees above the horizon when he saw it first.

He preferred not to give his name for publication, he said, because "most people seemed to laugh at those who reported unusual objects in the sky."
