

SAUCER WAS RAAF'S CUP OF TEA

A RAAF Mustang has been the unwitting cause of flying saucer reports in the northern wheatbelt areas.

Last Wednesday the Mustang flew to the Coorow, Dalwallinu area to carry out exercises.

Operating at about 30,000ft., it left long vapour trails.

Many people in the area saw the aircraft and variously reported it as a white ball and a pencil-like object.

However, the RAAF is sure that it was the Mustang that was reported, as the times, altitude and position all agree with the pilot's flight report.

The pilot also reported that he was making a vapour trail.
