

Councillors See "Flying Saucer"

CAPTAIN'S FLAT: Councillors T. P. Kerr and G. V. Burnett report having seen a "flying saucer" late on Tuesday afternoon, on their way home from the council meeting at Queanbeyan.

Cr. Burnett said that they were driving along the Captain's Flat Road, having descended from the hills to the Molonglo Valley near Foxlow, when the "flying saucer" was seen travelling from north towards the south at a very fast speed. It descended to a height of about 200 feet at an angle of about 30 degrees and then disappeared over the hills.

Cr. Kerr said that the object was surrounded by a bright green glow. It was about the same size as a large aircraft and had a short tail which appeared to emit flames. It was under observation for about sixty seconds and was seen outlined against the background of the mountains in the direction of Captain's Flat. Mr. Kerr said that it was in view whilst the car was travelling and both he and Mr. Burnett had sufficient time to discuss the object as it passed.
