

PASSENGERS AND TRAM DRIVER SAW FLYING SAUCER ?

BALLARAT, Wednesday — Further reports which came in yesterday suggest that a strange light seen to the west of Ballarat on Sunday night may have been one of the elusive flying saucers.

Mr. T. E. Carter, a tram driver, said he was driving a tram west along Sturt street, when a passenger drew his attention to the object which, he said, appeared as a bright circular white light about five inches in diameter.

The light was not moving, he said, and had the appearance of the planet Saturn, except that it was much bigger.

Mr. Carter said he and a number of passengers watched the light for two minutes, when it suddenly shot upwards and disappeared, changing its color to orange as it moved. He said the light faded gradually away.

Mr. John Heinz, an accountant, of Wendouree parade, said he was driving in Sturt street at the same time as Mr. Carter saw the light, 8.17 p.m., and he, too, saw the object. He gave an identical description, and placed it in the same area.
