

PARISH WARNED ABOUT SAUCERS

LONDON, Thursday: A minister wanted his 9,000 parishioners to watch for a flying saucer landing, the Daily Mail said today.

He had no doubt the saucers were from outer space, he said.

The minister is the Rev. Ronald Cartmel, amateur astronomer and vicar of Aldridge, Staffordshire.

Mr. Cartmel wrote in his parish magazine:—

“Don't smile. This matter of flying saucers is nothing to smile at.

Aldridge, welcome the visitors to our world. They seem friendly enough.”

To help prepare his parishioners for a landing, Mr. Cartmel, 54, a fellow of the Royal Astronomical Society, has recommended two books on flying saucers for his parishioners to read.
