

# **FLYING SAUCER REPORT**

**A flying saucer, changing in colour from green to yellow and red, was reported over Rockhampton by an observer about 8.40 p.m. yesterday.**

**It was in sight for about four to five minutes flying west towards Ridgeland and swinging in a pendulum motion from side to side.**

**The observer, Mr A. Curnow, who watched it through binoculars with his wife and son from the veranda of their home at Agnes Street, said that at one stage of its flight the saucer appeared also to have an upward and downward motion.**

**"In London I saw plenty of things in the sky during the war, but I never saw anything like this before," said Mr Curnow.**

**"My wife, who saw it first, thinks it was flat on one side and dome shaped on the other. It was moving from side to side erratically in the same manner that a motor car might skid along a road.**

**"It was moving downward**

but very gradually and was  
not in any way like a star," he  
added.
