

There's a MAN in this saucer

OSLO, Norway, Tuesday. — Police are seeking traces of a flying saucer — from which two young women claim a dark, long-haired, foreign-looking MAN emerged while they were picking berries.

They described the man as appearing friendly and anxious to talk, but he was unable to understand English, French or German.

After the man had vainly tried to explain himself with words, gestures and drawings, he climbed into the saucer which rose straight into the air and disappeared, they said.

The North Norway newspaper, Helgeland, reports the story of the women, two sisters aged 24 and 32, who live at Mosjoen.

They said the saucer was about 16 ft. in diameter and looked like two saucers put together.

"Like bumble-bee"

It started with a slight humming sound like a bumble-bee and rose at great speed.

The man wore a kind of khaki overall without buttons, but possibly with a belt.

The sisters at first suppressed their story for fear of being disbelieved. Then one told her husband

When the police questioned the sisters separately both told a similar story with only minor differences.
