

NO TRACE OF SAUCER

OSLO, August 25.—The police have decided that a flying saucer, plus a dark-haired occupant, which two sisters claimed to have seen in a wood, must have been just a beautiful dream.

Two sisters were picking blueberries, they said, when they came across a flying saucer parked in a grassy dell in the hills above Mosjoen (North Norway). There, too, was a dark stranger. They offered him a bucketful of blueberries. He refused them politely, leapt into his saucer and whizzed off, presumably into outer space.

Today police, accompanied by the sisters, surveyed the scene of this brief encounter. They could not find any sign that the spot had been in recent use as a saucer-park.

A male cousin of the sister told the police that the sisters before the incident, had been reading books on flying saucers.
