

FLYING SAUCER SCARE

SINGAPORE
(A.A.P.-Reuter). —A
flying saucer scare
swept Singapore on
Saturday night.

SEVERAL people reported
to the R.A.F. authorities
at the civil airport at Kal-
lang they had seen a fast
moving light which "could
only have been a flying
saucer."

An R.A.F. spokesman
said, "This is no leg pull."
Something strange has
been seen by at least six
people and probably many
more.

"We have no explanation
to offer yet."

engineer who was on duty at Kallang airport, said, "A Malay policeman came running in shouting that there was a strange light in the sky.

"I went out and saw a large white light, much bigger than any star, moving at terrific speed and quite low over the airport.

"The policeman said it had come from the southeast, which is in the direction of Sumatra."
