

"NO LEG-PULL" S'PORE SAUCER SCARE

SINGAPORE, September 5.
—A flying saucer scare swept Singapore to-night. Several people reported to the R.A.F. authorities at the civil airport at Kallang that they had seen a fast-moving light which "could have been only a flying saucer."

An R.A.F. spokesman said "This is no leg pull.

"Something strange has been seen by at least six people and probably many more. We have no explanation to offer yet."

Mrs. R. Whitley told Reuters that she saw a large white light, much bigger than any star, moving at a terrific speed and quite low over Kallang airport.

"The flying saucer circled at high speed and disappeared across the sea in the direction of Northern Sumatra," she said.

An R.A.F. spokesman said "It could not have been a star that people saw because there was a thick cloud over Singapore at the time—10.35 p.m. local time."
