

FLYING SAUCER SCARE SWEEPS SINGAPORE

SINGAPORE, September 4.—
A flying saucer scare swept Singapore tonight.

Several people reported to RAF authorities at the civil airport at Kallang that they had seen a fast-moving light which "could only have been a flying saucer."

An RAF spokesman said: "This is no leg pull. Something strange has been seen by at least six people and probably many more. We have no explanation to offer yet."

Mrs R. Whitley told Reuter she saw a large white light, much bigger than any star, moving at terrific speed and quite low over Kallang airport.

"The flying saucer circled at high speed and disappeared across the sea in the direction of Northern Sumatra," she said.

An RAF spokesman said: "It could not have been a star that people saw, because there was thick cloud over Singapore at
