

## **"FLYING SAUCER" OVER SINGAPORE**

SINGAPORE, Sunday.

A "flying saucer" scare swept through Singapore last night.

Several people told R.A.F. authorities they had seen a fast-moving light.

"It could only have been a flying saucer," they said.

An R.A.F. spokesman said: "This is no leg-pull. At least six people, and probably more, have been something strange.

"We have no explanation to offer yet."

Mrs. Rosemary Whitley, wife of a Government radio engineer who was on duty at Kailang airport, said:

"A Malay policeman came running in shouting that he had seen a strange light in the sky.

"I went out and saw a large white light, much bigger than any star.

"It was moving at a terrific speed and quite low over the airport.

"The flying saucer circled at high speed and disappeared across the sea in the direction of Northern Sumatra."
