

# Several See 'Saucer' Fly At Airport

**SINGAPORE, Sun.—A flying saucer scare swept Singapore last night.**

Several people reported to the R.A.F. authorities at the civil airport at Kallang that they had seen a fast moving light which "could only have been a flying saucer."

The R.A.F. spokesman said: "This is no 'leg-pull.' Something strange has been seen by at least six people and probably many more."

"We have no explanation to offer yet," he said.

Mrs. Rosemary Whitley, wife of a Government radio engineer who was on duty at Kallang Airport, said: "A Malay policeman came running in shouting that there was a strange light in the sky.

"I went out and saw a large white light much bigger than any star moving at terrific speed and quite low over the airport."

An R.A.F. spokesman said: "It could not possibly have been a star that people saw because there was thick cloud over Singapore at the time—
