

Flying saucer 'photographed'

MILDURA, Friday. — Three station employees who claimed on Wednesday to have seen a flying saucer at Wilcannia, 160 miles from Broken Hill, are saying no more about it.

But Sgt. J. H. B. Sewell said the men had taken photographs which had been developed and sent to the Civil Aviation Department.

Housekeeper of Mena Murtee Station, where the men said they saw the saucer, said today she believed the whole thing was a hoax.

But Sgt. Sewell said he knew two of the men, Keith Watson and Charlie Marshall, who were reliable types.

The men told police they saw the saucer, "as big as a woolshed, hovering 500 feet up, and mak-

ing 500 feet up, and making a terrific noise".
