

NAVY PROBE ON FLYING SAUCERS

CANBERRA, Thursday:
Flying saucers reported by a Nowra fleet air arm pilot are being investigated by naval headquarters in Melbourne.

The pilot, Lt O'Farrell saw two objects, which he took to be flying saucers, when flying at night over Goulburn NSW on a return trip to Nowra.

He told authorities at Nowra that he saw what appeared to be the lights of two aircraft when flying at about 285 miles an hour.

He said a "saucer" moved on each side of him circled his plane and then drew rapidly away.

At his request the Nowra radar crew fixed his position and reported back that the screen showed an echo of another object moving alongside his Sea Fury.

This is the first known case in which unidentified objects in the sky have been confirmed by radar.
