

SKY OBJECT NOT SUCH A MYSTERY

MELBOURNE. — A "flying saucer" seen over Melbourne early Sunday morning was dismissed as a meteor yesterday by Mr. Arthur Clarke, former chairman of the British Inter - Planetary Society.

Mr. Clarke, who is visiting Melbourne, said there was nothing mysterious about the object. Any bright moving object seen in the sky at night was almost certainly a meteor.

He said meteors flashed from space into the earth's atmosphere at speeds of up to 100,000 miles an hour, and the friction caused a brilliant burst of light.
