

# Strange Object in Sky

## FIJIAN OBSERVERS PUZZLED

Suva, Aug. 5. — Another sky phenomenon seen at night has puzzled hundreds of Suva (Fiji) observers. The object which first appeared over the city near the east, was still visible at 3 a.m. yesterday.

Mr. Hari Ram, a science master at the Marist Brothers' College in Suva, said he saw a spindle-shaped deep golden-yellow light moving to the north from the east.

Three distinct rods of light radiated. The longest was vertical and its tapering end was curved and diffused.

For more than one hour the rays continually changed and several times assumed the shape of a plus sign.

The meteorological officer in charge of Laucala Bay said his office could not explain the object.—A.A.P.-Reuter.
