

Compensation Claim After Seeing 'Saucer'

TRENTON (New Jersey), Thursday (A.A.P.).—A "Flying Saucer" that was said to have unleashed an "overpowering odour" will be the grounds for action next Monday by Harry Sturdivant, a former night-watchman, when he asks for disability benefits in a hearing before the State workmen's compensation referee.

Sturdivant alleges an unidentified flying object—shaped like a flying saucer or cigar—frightened him out of his sense of taste and smell on October 1.

Sturdivant said to-day he was terrified by the "glowing, smelling" object which, he reported, zoomed low over the Dela-

zoomed low over the Delaware River and was visible for five seconds. He said it "hissed."

"It gave off a bad odour — so bad that I could not even drink my coffee later," Sturdivant said.
