

Claims Flying Saucer Men Super-intelligent

MELBOURNE, Tuesday.—*Flying saucer men could take over the world to-night, but they were too sensible to become involved in man's conflicts, Mr. Fred Stone, an Australian flying saucer investigator, said to-night.*

Mr. Stone, the national director of the Australian Flying Saucer Research Society, told an overflow meeting of more than 200 persons that flying saucers were manned by super-intelligent beings, waiting their opportunity to lead the world to a new age.

But first the nations of the world must learn to live in peace, said Mr. Stone.

Other points made by Mr. Stone were:

Flying saucers were of two types—mother ships, about the same size as conventional aircraft, and "foo discs," which were tiny craft used for reconnaissance purposes.

One of the keenest saucer enthusiasts was the Duke of Edinburgh, who had every report of flying saucers sent to him for study.

Saucers came from outer space, from one of the many other universes. Likely points of origin were the planets Mars and Venus.

References in the Bible proved that saucers were known in ancient times and were not a recent phenomenon.

A 20-mile long artificial bridge had been built on the moon within the past 15 years.
