

Flying Object Identified

LONDON, Thursday (A.A.P.-Reuter).—It is reported here that the U.F.O.—Unidentified Flying Object—which R.A.F. Javelins failed to intercept in a chase down the English Channel on April 29, has been identified.

The Daily Express said to-day that the U.F.O. was a new British plane and that Air Minister, Mr. Ward, would tell the Commons about it next week.

Reuter quoted "an authoritative source" as saying that the mysterious object had been identified, but Air Ministry officials would not reveal the secret before Mr. Ward makes his statement.
