

FLYING SAUCER DAMAGES CLAIM FAILS

NEW YORK, Tuesday
(A.A.P.-Reuter). — A New Jersey night watchman, who claimed he was injured when he saw a flying saucer, has been denied workers' compensation benefits on grounds that the saucer "developed within his own mental process."

Roger Kelly, director of the State Workmen's Compensation Division, ruled at Newark that Harry Sturdevant, 67, had failed to prove that the injuries were caused by his employment.
