

"Flying Saucer" Ready For Flight

LONDON, Monday (A.A.P.).—Britain's "flying saucer" was ready for its first flight, **The News Chronicle** reported. The revolutionary Saunders-Roe machine was completed a few days ago, and moved out to a slipway on the edge of the Solent at the company's works in the Isle of Wight, the newspaper said.

Engine testing had already begun. The first hover, probably a few inches above the ground, was expected within the next few days. The read trials, with the saucer hovering over water—the job for which it was designed—were expected in about 10 days.
