

Hovercraft To Try To Cross Channel

L O N D O N. Thursday (A.A.P.-Reuter). — Britain's "flying saucer," the experimental Hovercraft, will attempt to cross the English Channel from Dover to Calais on Saturday—the 50th anniversary of Louis Bleriot's trans-Channel flight.

The Daily Express, reporting this to-day, said the Hovercraft was expected to cross from England to France in 50 minutes. The regular sea ferry service on the Dover-Calais run takes about one hour and 20 minutes.

The Express said that the flight could clear the way for 100-ton cross-Channel saucers carrying 300 passengers at 120 m.p.h.
