

"SAUCER" MYSTERY DEEPENS

BRISBANE, Sunday.—North Queensland's "flying saucers" mystery deepened to-day with reports of a silvery white object on a hillside and more reported sightings of coloured "rockets."

The silvery white object was seen by a search party on Prince of Wales Island where a bright green rocket-like object flashed across the sky on Friday night.

To-day four fishermen at Karumb Lodge in the Gulf of Carpentaria reported having seen a greenish red light move across the sky last night.

The first unidentified flying object was reported by

two people on Thursday Island on Friday night.

They said the object about 45ft. long flew across the sky to nearby Prince of Wales Island and disappeared.

Five Thursday Island residents went by boat to Prince of Wales Island to-day to investigate and reported they had seen a silvery white object gleaming in the sun

on a hillside about a mile away.

When night fell they had

When night fell they had to return to their boat before being able to investigate farther.

Thursday Island police reported that an object had been seen in the sky at Newcastle Bay about 50 miles from Thursday Island five minutes before the object was sighted off Thursday Island.
