Light Was Probably a Meteor

ADELAIDE. — A brilliant moving light in the sky reported early yesterday by observers in many parts of S.A. and Victoria was probably a meteor.

At about the time dozens of persons reported having seen the light, a radar scanner operated at the University of Adelaide picked up a meteor, and the trace was recorded on film.

"If our record was the thing seen, then it was a comparatively slow meteor bearing 14 deg. west of south from here," Mr. B. J. Stone, a Ph.D. student connected with the meteor research project, said yesterday.
