# More 'flying saucers' spotted

**BUENOS AIRES, Sunday (AAP).—**Another unidentified flying object has been spotted in South America.

The latest of several sightings of 'flying saucers' was spotted today over the River Plate, the 28-mile wide river that divides Argentina and Uruguay.

Several similar objects have been sighted over Buenos Aires, the Argentine capital.

### Stopped clocks

Yesterday's "flying saucer" was spotted by six people walking along a deserted beach near Colonia, Uruguay, which is situated across the River Plate from Buenos Aires.

On July 10 a peasant couple in a village near Oporto, Portugal, reported seeing a pinkish unidenti-

fied object at about 3,000 feet in the sky.

They said they saw the object at the same time some static broke out on

some static broke out on their radio.

Airport authorities said electro magnetic clocks stopped for 10 minutes while the cylindrical white object was overhead.

One of the six who spotted the flying object from Uruguay, a 17-year-old youth told Uruguayan police that the object he saw was cigar-shaped, reddish in colour, and about 32 feet above the river. It was not far out from the beach.

It moved upward when he started running towards it and left behind a trail of white vapour similar to that of a jet engine.

The other five people in the party, two of whom were adults, confirmed his story.

Several people reported spotting unidentified flying objects over Buenos Aires shortly after sunset on Friday.

They described the ob-

They described the objects, some of which were photographed, as cigar shaped and emitting colours ranging from reddish greens to blues.

All described the intensity of the light the objects emitted as very bright.

All observers in Buenos Aires noted that the objects seemed to remain stationary for about 15 minutes before moving away to disappear in the northwest, towards Uruguay.
