This is the advice of Miss June Marsden, the earnest president of the Aquarian Researchers' Association.

Last night she lectured a group of about 50 enthusiastic followers plus a percentage of cheerful sceptics in Sydney.

"I am a prophet and an astrologer," Miss Marsden began, untangling cords and setting up a tape recorder for a rendition of blipping, electronic "space music".

"Many of my prophecies have so far taken place," she lilted.
