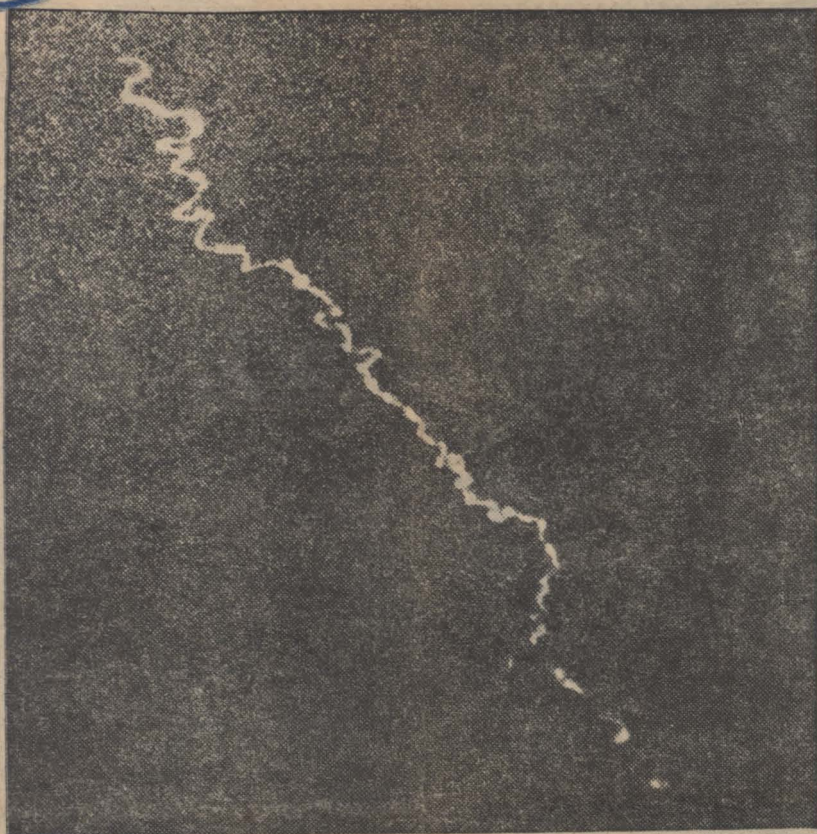

"They disappeared over the horizon to the north."
