

FARMER TELLS OF TRIP IN MARTIAN CRAFT

LOCO, TEXAS, Sunday (AAP). — This tiny West Texas farming community bears a name which may not help close the flying saucer credibility gap.

Nevertheless, Mr Carroll Watts, a sober-minded, 29-year-old farmer known to his neighbours as a man "of reliable character" was yesterday seeking a congressional investigation into his report that he saw a spacecraft

of grey skin, broad flat noses, a thin line mouth, no hair, and eye sockets that ran back nearly to their ears", he said.

Dr J. Allen Hynek, an astronomer, professor at North Western University and special consultant to the Air Force on unidentified flying objects, said pictures Mr Watts forwarded to him were quite clear. "And everyone I've talked to there with him give him a clear bill of health as far as he is not being a fake".
