ON Saturday night the deputy chairman of the ACT Advisory Council, Mr T. W. W. Pye, will open the third annual UFO Convention to be held at the Academy of Science under the auspices of the Commonwealth Aerial Phenomena Investigation Organisation (CAPIO to its friends).

Actually the first session kicks off at the Griffin Centre at 11am, and moves to the Institute of Anatomy at 2.30pm. So the conference — like the manifestations observed by its members — may be seen in three different places on the one day.
