

'Flying saucer' on film

MELBOURNE,
Monday. — A professional photographer from Deniliquin, NSW, took a series of 13 photographs today of a "flying saucer" that has appeared in the area on the past three nights.

Mr Geoff Allan, with five friends sat at Seven's Weir, about 17 miles from Deniliquin, all through last night and this morning.

"It appeared about 4am and stayed around until about 8.15am", he said. "It seemed to come from nowhere".

"I just couldn't believe it. I was petrified", he said today.

Mr Allan said that the "thing" took about five minutes to rise to about 1,000ft and then stayed there.

"It had no particular shape, but it was silvery white and was 500 times brighter than any star in the sky at the time", he said.

Mr Allan said he used a 35mm camera with a 210mm telezoom lens to photograph the mystery object.
