And hundreds of

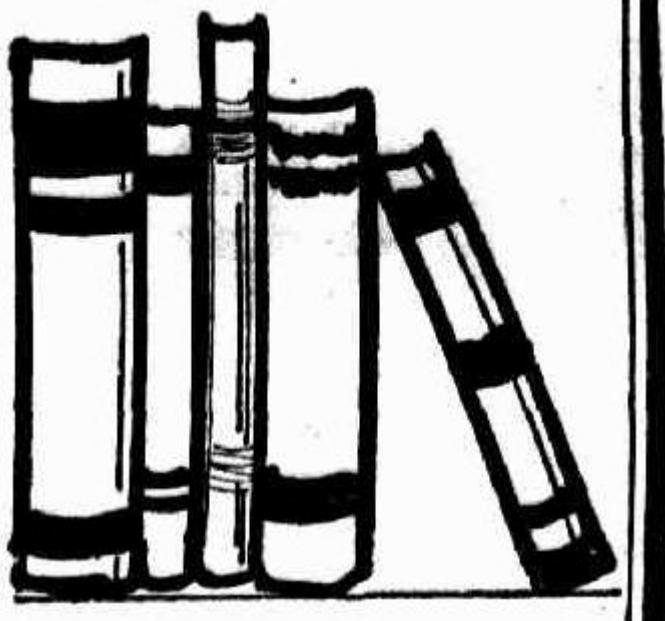
And hundreds of sightings came in from Warminster, Wiltshire, all through the 60's.
