

# Navy will see man about UFO

**HOBART, Wednesday.** — A Hobart man who saw an unidentified flying object last month will be interviewed by a Navy Department official.

Mr M. G. Beven said today he was told this by police on Monday night.

Mr Beven said that on October 28 he and his wife and their neighbours in Bowen Street, St Helens, Hobart, Mr and Mrs J. Riley, watched a cigar-shaped object flying across the sky.

## Watched for 8 minutes

"It was about 6.6pm when I first saw it, and I watched it for about eight minutes", Mr Beven said.

"It was at a tremendous height — about 60,000 ft".

When he looked at the object through a pair of cheap field glasses he said he could make out the colours of red, white and blue.

"It had two small fins and could have been a rocket, but it was travelling too slow", he said.

The object moved slower than a jet, made no noise, but left a long, white vapour trail.
