UFOs TO APPEAR AT SHOW

The sky over Mt Hagen will be full of UFOs during the show later this year.

But show organisers have passed on the advice — don't go screaming "Martians are landing" to the police.

The UFOs — unidentified Flying Objects — have been identified to DCA authorities as miniature planes and parachutists.

The Assistant District Commissioner for Mt Hagen, Mr Ross Allan, and other members of the Mt Hagen Miniature Squadron, will demonstrate their machines at the show, to be held

at the show, to be held on August 27-28.

They had to obtain special permission from DCA to stage the demonstration.

The scale aircraft will be flown in a restricted area to ensure there is no danger to aircraft using the Kagamuga airstrip.

Parachutists from the Port Moresby Sky Diving Club will again be featured at the show.

A show society spokesman said the parachutists were "scene stealers" at the last show.

The jumpers, known to village people as "man long lusim balus na podaun", excited the people so much that the show committee was inundated with requests for a repeat performance.

Organisers said accommodation again threatened to be a major problem for tourists going to the show.

A spokesman said the show society would not handle accommodation bookings this year.

Bookings would be arranged by Ansett and TAA.

Limited space was available at the primary A, primary T, high and vocational schools, he said.

All motels and hotels are booked out already.
