

# UFO SIGHTING CLAIM NEAR FARM BEACH

An unidentified flying object seen near Farm Beach was carefully studied by a local electronics engineer and pilot as it hovered for 15 minutes close to an isolated farm house.

The object, described as being gold in colour, was seen by Mr Don Grouse, his wife Pam and Mr John Howden as they returned to Port Lincoln from Sceales Bay recently.

The UFO was first seen at 9.45 pm while the group was making mechanical repairs to their car.

"From an angle of 70 degrees in the sky it dropped vertically and apparently under perfect control to within about 50 ft of the sea." Mr Grouse

of the sea," Mr Grouse said.

"It was about three miles from us and in travelling short distances to the north and west occasionally rose or fell 20 ft to 30 ft which we checked by sighting the object through the buckle hole of a seat belt."

"It was a clear night and the UFO appeared to be close to a near-by farm house. The object emitted a golden hue similar to a sodium vapour light. It finally travelled slowly

finally travelled slowly southwards and eventually disappeared."

Mr Grouse said it was niether a plane nor a helicopter and that in eight years as a pilot he had never seen anything like it before.
