

Expert coming to investigate U.F.O. report

Mr. Peter Powell of the UFO Research and Investigation, Adelaide, will visit Port Lincoln next week to investigate local reports.

The increasing number of reported sightings of UFO (unidentified flying objects) has led Mr. Powell to make this visit to Eyre Peninsula.

So that people can contact Mr. Powell and discuss anything unusual they have seen, he will be stationed in a caravan on the foreshore lawns opposite the State Bank, in Port Lincoln, next Wednesday, May 10, and Thursday, May 11, during the day.

where he will inspect the unusual markings in a paddock owned by Mr. and Mrs. Robert Habner.

Films will be taken of the markings and the locality, soil samples will be taken for further analysis and Mr. Powell hopes to meet and interview neighbours.

On Tuesday, May 9, Mr. Powell will be guest speaker at the Murdinga Agricultural Bureau's meeting in the Murdinga Hall where he will speak on UFO and show slides.
