A Coolamon family watched a white unidentified flying object with a "flaming red tail" hover over the Riverina for 15 minutes on Sunday morning.

Before breakfast on Sunday morning, Mr. John Campbell of "Austral-Eden", a property two miles from Coolamon on the Temora Road, was milking a cow.

He noticed a "queer cloud formation" appear in a cloudless sky.

He lined it up with a tree and noticed the "thing" didn't move.

"Then, all of a sudden, it dipped and shot off to the left."

Mr. Campbell called to his wife Jeanette, who came out of the house.
