**Flying
object
mystery**

WARWICK: It appears that the 13 Christian Brothers' College students were not the only ones to see the mysterious flying object which passed over Warwick on Thursday afternoon.

Five students from Warwick High School reported yesterday that they too saw the object.

They were training on Slade oval at approximately 3.40 p.m. on Thursday when the object was noticed.

In their own words: "It was seen in the south-east sky, heading south at about the speed R.A.F. jets go over. It was very bright silver, and seen in front of a cloud. The sun was temporarily hidden by another cloud.

"It was visible for about two minutes, at about 30 degrees from the horizon."

They all stated that it was like no other aircraft they had seen, and no noise was heard.

Although the object was first thought to be some kind of balloon, this was discounted after a more observant member of the group noticed it was travelling in the opposite direction to the wind.
