

# Kimba couple see colourful U.F.O.

Suspended in the middle of the hovering ten-foot-tall orange light was a man who appeared to be dressed in a white space suit.

This was the description given of the UFO seen by Mr Brian Hunt of Kimba and his companion Sharyn Finckler, 32 miles from the town recently.

They told Kimba Police that they saw the 10 ft. high by 5 ft. wide light suspended some 3 ft. off the ground about 30 yards from the side of the road on which they were travelling.

Mr Hunt said they could clearly see a man within the light and said he looked like a modern day astronaut. The couple returned to the area of the sighting with a Police officer but nothing was found.

A truck driver is re-

ported to have seen a similar object. Last year there were a number of sightings of unidentified

sightings of unidentified flying objects on Eyre Peninsula beginning with the discovery of a "saucer nest" at Tooligie Hill.

## EXCITING

Mr Peter Powell, director of UFO Research and Investigation, Adelaide said today he had visited Kimba to make enquiries about the report, described as an occupant sighting and labelled it as "the most exciting for 20 years."

"During this period there have been five occupant sightings reported in South Aust -

ralia and this has been the first we have been able to investigate," he said.

A full report complete with diagrams and conclusions is now being completed by the UFO group and will be published within a week or two. Mr Powell said he expected the report to be controversial and interesting to the public.

He said tests were continuing on soil sam-

continuing on soil samples taken from the Tooligie Hill saucer nest but to date, possibly because they had been taken some time after the creation of the nest, little of significance had been revealed.
