

# Six men sight UFO over north

BRISBANE, Tuesday. — Six men at a northern Queensland cattle station saw objects that appeared to be "stars with tails of light" moving toward the south-east across the sky at 6am today.

Mr Terry O'Neill, 49, a taxi driver, said, "I was taking a bloke to work just on daybreak. I deposited him at the men's quarters at 6am when somebody said, 'Look at the lights'.

"There were at least seven, probably 10, and three were slightly brighter than the others".

They were not in formation. Mr O'Neill said five other men outside the quarters at Canobie Station, 120 miles north of

tion, 120 miles north of Julia Creek, also saw the lights.

However, Mr O'Neill said he had seen a more brilliant UFO in 1948. He also had seen comets and meteors and could distinguish them from what he saw today.

MELBOURNE, Tuesday. — An unidentified flying object sighted over Victoria last night has been identified as a Soviet satellite.

After investigating a flood of reports about "a bright light" which travelled at high speed and left a vapour trail, RAAF officials decided it was Cosmos 526, which was due to re-enter the earth's atmosphere between April 3 and 10.
