

Was it really a U.F.O?

At 5.30pm on June 18 a mysterious object was sighted in the sky above Paraburdoo.

It appeared to consist of a large sphere supporting a smaller sphere. No accurate dimensions could be given to these objects because they appeared to be a great height.
