

# MORE FLYING OBJECTS SEEN

More UFO sightings have come to light since Times reports of UFO activity in the district.

Local representative of the Australian Flying Saucer Research Society (Mr. Neville Hardy) has taken details of an object which dived cleanly into the sea near a fishing boat steaming off Thevenard five years ago.

Cummins teacher Mr. P. White who in July last year was followed by an object for 14 miles.

He was able to define its shape from the red lights around its exterior and said it had a cross-like structure beneath a umbrella-like dome.

Mr. White was travelling out of Port Lincoln on the evening that he saw the UFO. It began following him near the Port Lincoln golf links.

ber Derek Turner saw a very bright light with red underside over Boston Bay. The object occasionally faded, leaving only a white haze, and when shining brightly could be seen to change position regularly. It later gained altitude and remained steady.

Mr. Hardy rang the Flying Saucer Research Society's office in Adelaide and found the object had also been seen from Adelaide.

"Whatever it was seems to have been positioned high in the sky between the two cities," Mr. Hardy said.

A second similar object was seen the same evening by the watchers.
