

U.F.O. sighting by Tumby man

"I never believed in UFO's but by —
it's true."

An incredulous Tumby Bay man, Mr. Max Cornwall, said this on Tuesday evening shortly after seeing a green, top-like UFO while travelling south on the road between Peachna and Tooligie.

"It was eerie and frightening," he said.

"My car filled with green light for two or three seconds as the UFO moved westwards at considerable speed. I caught a glimpse of it out of the top right hand side of my windscreen. It was green, round and thinner at the top like a top.

"I was amazed. I could not estimate its speed but I've seen planes doing 900 mph and they were stand-

mph and they were standing still in comparison to this".

Mr. Cornwall said he saw the unidentified flying object at about 6.30 p.m., four miles from Tooligie.

He has reported the sighting to a UFO investigating group.

A strange flying object was also seen at Chanda-da and Streaky Bay within minutes of Mr. Cornwall's sighting.

Mrs. C. T. Maywald, of Streaky Bay reported the object near the township, and shortly afterwards at 6.40 p.m. a second sighting was made at Chanda-da.

Jane Ryan 14 and her younger brothers, Paul and Damian were driving on their parents' property when they saw the object about 50 feet away and moving at 30 mph in a north-south direction.

The children said the object appeared to be in the shape of two eyes, each about two feet by three feet in size. It was greenish blue in colour and left a luminous trail.

It was visible for 15 to 20 seconds and the children said flames emitted from the object.
