Mother 'left on UFO for space trip'

PORTLAND, Oregon Sunday (AAP). — A father has won custody of two children on the grounds that their mother left on a UFO voyage to outer space and never returned.

Mr Stephen Berlow was granted the two children by the Circuit Court in Tillamook, Oregon, after filing an affidavit saying the mother had chosen to leave them behind and follow a mysterious couple believed to have induced at least 20 people in Oregon to abandon their possessions and loved ones for a flying-saucer trip into eternity.

The children were identified as Noah, 1, and Jennifer 3, who lived as the children of Sue and Ron Greenberg, who have vanished. Mr Berlow said he

October 1 and left two days later.

He said the group's leader told him they "believed in the kingdom of the father". That was the theme used by a couple who held a meeting on September 14 in Waldport, Oregon, after which the 20 gave away or signed over their belongings to make a journey, through human metamorphosis to a higher plane than earth by way of UFO.

actually was the children's father and had been supporting them.
