

UFOs on agenda

UNITED NATIONS, Tuesday (AAP). — The United Nations formally took up today the question of unidentified flying objects, the Associated Press reported.

“The world is looking on”, declared Sir Eric Gairy, Prime Minister of the tiny Caribbean island nation of Grenada and prime mover behind a campaign to get the United Nations to study UFO phenomena world-wide.

He said he had been encouraged by President Carter’s apparent interest in the subject.

Mr Carter, who like Sir Eric says he once saw a UFO, recently instructed the National Aeronautics and Space Administration to resume a UFO study that had been suspended by the US Air Force 10 years ago.
