UFOs fly off UN agenda

UNITED NATIONS, Wednesday (AAP-Reuter). — The secret of flying saucers is safe, for the time being at least, from investigation by the United Nations.

The General Assembly's Special Political Committee shelved last night a motion calling for a full-scale study of unidentified flying objects.

The Prime Minister of Grenada, Sir Eric Gairy, moving the motion had called for international action to investigate the mys-
