Ship pilot sees UFO

Captain Frank Jolly, a Port Phillip Bay ship pilot, believes he sighted an unidentified flying object over his Brighton home at the weekend.

Captain Jolly, 50, said he had studied a saucer-like object in the sky for about a minute as he was sunbaking in his backyard.

He said the object, which appeared to be about 18m in diameter, was flying at about 1000m and it gradually got lower until it disappeared behind a house. He has reported his sighting to the RAAF.
