

UFO probe urged

There have been frequent sightings of unidentified flying objects in Papua New Guinea in recent months, Parliament was told yesterday.

These sightings were confusing and worrying village people in the Central and Western Provinces and the Gusap Dumpu area of the Madang Province, the former Transport Minister, Mr Jephcott (Madang), and Mr Kala Swokin (Western) said during

ern) said during Question Time.

Mr Jephcott said that five UFO sightings were tracked on radar in the Gusap area by Air Niugini in December, and several others were reported in September.

"These sightings have become continuous and frequent and are upsetting village people," Mr Jephcott said.

Mr Swokin said the Defence Force should investigate recent sightings in the Central and Western Provinces.

The Defence Minister, Mr Duwabane, told Parliament that his department will investigate and make a report.

Commenting on the Gusap reports, the general manager of Air Niugini, Mr Bryan Grey said: "We've heard nothing about it.
