

# Police in PNG see a UFO

PORT MORESBY, Wed: Three of Papua New Guinea's most senior police officers and 20 other policemen said today that they watched an unidentified flying object in the northern sky for more than an hour.

Assistant - Commissioner David Tasion, Supt. Paul Tohian and the police public-relations officer, Mr Leith Anderson, said they were on a special operation at 3.15 am at a village near Port Moresby when they saw a UFO in a fixed position in the sky and "Like a bright searchlight which kept switching off and on for about two-minute intervals."

They said that the object's light intensity varied from "a faint glimmer to full brightness before dimming and going out again."
