DRIVERS CLAIM CHASED BY UFO'S

IT'S UFO time again in Breaker Morant country.

In the past week there have been several reported sightings of UFOs in the picturesque rural region of Clare, 130km north of Adelaide, where the film Breaker Morant was shot.

The drivers of two cars reported being followed by a brilliant red object.

In the latest sighting, last Sunday, three young people claimed they were chased by a UFO.

Michael Hallett, 20, Lyn Hann, 18, and her sister Judy, were returning from a birthday party about 8.30 pm when they noticed the red glow in the sky.

"At first we thought it may have been a fire so we stopped the car and wound down the windows to get a better look," Lyn said.

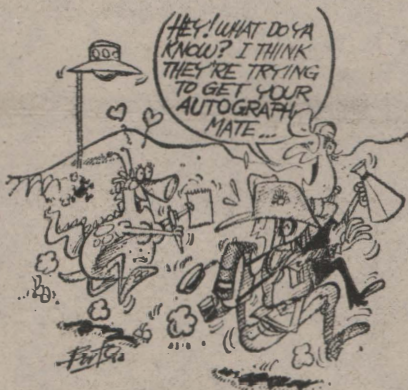
"When it got brighter and closer we realised it wasn't a fire. It was really eerie.

"Michael put his foot down and locked the doors. But the object chased us for about three kilometres before it vanished."

Michael said the object was about as big as his car and drew right alongside.

It was rectangular in shape with four rays of light at what looked to be the front of the object.

A spokesman for the Australian International UFO Research Group in Adelaide, Mr C. Norris, said the latest sighting followed similar reports last week by a farmer and a woman motorist in the area.

"The Clare area is notorious for UFO sightings," he said.

Mr Norris said UFO reports in the area were very prevalent this time of the year with next month usually being one of maximum sightings.
